

Shenandoah County Utilities Maintenance Mechanic/Plant Operator Stoney Creek Sanitary District

Job Summary

The Utilities Maintenance Mechanic/Plant Operator at the Stoney Creek Sanitary District performs intermediate semi-skilled and skilled work in the installation, repair and maintenance of water and sewer pumps and general equipment at the water and wastewater facilities; operates water and wastewater treatment facilities as needed; does related work as required. Work is performed under the regular supervision of the Maintenance and Construction Supervisor (SCSD).

Essential Job Functions

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform the essential job functions satisfactorily. The County provides reasonable accommodations to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the primary functions herein described.

- Performs maintenance on equipment at the water and wastewater treatment facilities.
- Performs maintenance on water and sewer pump stations.
- Troubleshoots electrical components.
- Operates basic mechanical and electrical hand tools.
- Reads meters, gauges and dials, and keeps logs of readings.
- Performs general grounds maintenance tasks.
- Installs and repairs water meters.
- Conducts bi-monthly radio meter readings.
- Assists with operations at the water and wastewater treatment facilities as needed.
- Collects samples, conducts laboratory tests as needed.

Education and Experience

Any combination of education and experience equivalent to graduation from high school and basic electrical and maintenance experience.

Licenses or Certifications

Possession of an appropriate driver's license valid in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

The annual starting pay range for this FLSA Non-Exempt position is **\$41,902.81 - \$48,188.24**, commensurate with qualifications, experience, and internal equity.

The County offers an excellent benefits package, including Virginia Retirement System, health and dental insurance, vacation and sick leave, and holidays. The successful candidate must pass a pre-employment, post-offer drug screening and background check.
